A suggestion was made to have CAB members attend the June 16<sup>th</sup> Planning Board meeting to voice our concerns about flag lots.

Leonard Janiga informed the Board that the PACE program grant we applied for was turned down. Out of 42 applications received, only 15 were granted.

Regarding “sunshine rules” Leonard Janiga is in agreement with the existing CAB rules as stated in the Code book.
