DOG CENSUS

The Town will be conducting a dog census this summer. Employees having Town ID will be coming to your neighborhood checking on licensed dogs. Dogs 4 months and older must be licensed. To license your dog you need proof of rabies and if the dog is spayed or neutered. The fee is \$5 for a spayed or neutered dog and \$13 if your dog is not altered. Residents with unlicensed dogs may receive a summons.
