The Town of Marilla continues to move fiscally in a responsible and sustainable direction:

- The past 3 years the Town remained under the Tax Cap
- Overall Taxes have decreased by over 3.6%
- Significant budget savings in our Water Districts
- Short term debt limited: 2014 had \$335,000 of debt in 2016 completely paid off
- Long term debt has decreased significantly
- Total Reserve Funds established to purchase future equipment needs
- \$400,000 in Worker's Compensation Reserve Fund
- Town has received a Double AA rating from Standard and Poor's
- Lowered Town Insurance cost by over \$12,000 with better coverage
- The Town's improved fiscal and management policies have been yielding significant benefits to the Town Residents
- The Town is continuing to move in a positive direction in many other areas:
 1. Participating in the Erie County Sheriff's Prescription Drug Collection Program (drop off at Town Hall)
 2. Partnering with the County on providing a Senior Lunch Program (Monday & Friday)
 3. Providing WiFi and

- upgraded internet service for the Town Hall, Community Center and Historical Society, which will provide greater security at a lower cost
- 4. Purchased land in front of the Town Park to buffer the Park from development and provide future Park expansion if needed
- 5. Keeping Sewage Sludge out of the Town to protect our Residents and the environment
- 6. Applying for a Community Block Grant to install an elevator in the front of the Town Hall (hope to install in 2018 making easier access to Town Offices)
- 7. Working to retain our Post Office- the plan is to offer space at the front area of the Community Center-easy access and parking the rent received would offset any costs incurred

Rubbish Pick-up



The Fall rubbish collection will start on **Monday September 25th**, 2017. Please do not wait for your regular trash day as this is a separate collection. All items **MUST** be at roadside by 7:00 am on the 25th as there will be no return trips. **Individuals bringing rubbish from outside the Town will be prosecuted. If you see anyone dumping trash, please call the Sheriff's Dept. Accepted Materials** include; appliances, dryers, drained hot water tanks, refrigerators and freezers with doors removed. Also accepted are bulky items such as overstuffed furniture, mattresses, box springs, and other furniture. Metals of various types will also be accepted

EXCEPT new or used metal drums or barrels of any size, ex: 55 gal. drums.

NO items should be over 12 feet in length. Old window glass can be included in your regular sanitation pick-up.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE include *any item containing gasoline, garbage, construction and demolition materials, ex: plasterboard, concrete, bricks, wood, roofing materials, poisons, acids, caustics, explosives, ashes, brush, junk vehicles, animal waste, compost materials, tires, batteries and used motor oil.*

PLEASE MARK any container which you do not want taken during cleanup "**SAVE**"; as **the Town WILL NOT** be responsible for them, nor will they replace any items put at roadside in error. Questions contact: **Ron Unverdorben 652-7311**
