The United States Postal Service will be relocating the Marilla Post Office from its present location. The owners of the Marilla Country Store have chosen not to renew the lease which expires August 15th, 2018.

The Town has offered space for the Marilla Post Office to be located in the front of the Community Center. This location would allow for easier and safer access, better parking and also additional income for the Town; which will benefit all residents.

The Historical Museum would be moved to the Annex at the rear of the Community Center. The Annex would be renovated to become the new Museum.

The Town Historian would remain upfront at the Historian's present location.

The Historical Society currently has over 5100 square feet; of which 2000 square feet were obtained in 2014 from the purchase of the Roloff House and the cabin that was moved to the Roloff location. The Post Office has over 1000 square feet at its current location.

There will be an Informational Public Meeting requested by the United States Postal Service to listen to public input on Thursday, April 19th, 2018 at 6:30 pm at the Community Center; 1810 Two Rod Road. Anyone wishing for more information can contact the Town Clerk's Office at 652-5350.

There are petitions at the Town Clerk's Office for anyone wishing to sign (in favor of or against the location).
