The residents of the Town will be seeing a number of positive changes in and around the Town buildings.


- At the Town Hall an elevator in the front of the building for easier access to Town Offices. A \$91,000 Community Development Grant was secured to help fund this project. Work has begun, projected to be completed in October of this year.
- 2. The Marilla Post Office will be relocating in front of the Community Center. Work has started; the USPS is planning on having the new location ready for the Holiday Season. This will bring additional revenue for the Town. My plan is to use this revenue toward funding our Town Events.
- 3. The Marilla Country Store will be using the additional space vacated by the Post Office to expand the Store and provide a bigger selection of goods.
- 4. The Historical Society will be getting a new building for displaying their collection of Historical artifacts. The building will also house the Town Historian and his office. The building will be located behind the Town Hall next to the Roloff House. This will provide the Town and the Historical Society with a "Historical Complex"; something I think we can all be proud of . We are working with State Senator Gallivan's Office to secure \$100,000 worth of funding for this project. At this time it looks

- very promising. Our hope is to have this completed in early 2019.
- The Space not used by the Post Office in front of the Community Center will be used as an additional meeting room and office for the Town Hall. This will happen once the new Historical Building is completed.

The Town of Marilla continues to be in excellent fiscal health going into 2019. The Budget process has begun. At this time I see no significant increase in taxes except under Sanitation. This is due to increased operating costs beyond our control. This increase should be partly offset by a decrease in Fire Protection costs. I will provide the residents with a more detailed breakdown once I complete my Budget and final review of finances.

#### **New This Year for Enhanced** STAR!!!!

For 2019. There are separate applications for the Enhanced Star and Senior Citizens Exemptions. Previously, there they were combined into one.

The NYS Legislature changed the law to make the ENHANCED STAR INCOME VERIFICATION PROGRAM MANDATORY. The form will be included in your packets. Renewal packets will have new forms to complete and instructions will be included. Please complete all forms that you receive and submit to the Assessor's Office on or before March 1st, 2019.

New Homeowners must apply online for their Star Exemption at www.tax.ny.gov/star.

Homeowners may also register by phone weekdays between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm at (518) 457-2036. Turning 65 within 2019 year? Contact the Assessor's Office for

additional information for potential benefits. All other exemptions are

processed in our office and are due on or before March 1st, 2019. Exemptions may include: Low Income Disability, Veterans **Exemptions, Business Exemptions** and/or Agricultural Exemptions.

### Rubbish Pick-up



The Fall rubbish collection will start on **Monday September 24**<sup>th</sup> , 2018. Please do not wait for your regular trash day as this is a separate collection. All items MUST be at roadside by 7:00 am on the 25<sup>th</sup> as there will be no return trips. Individuals bringing rubbish from outside the Town will be prosecuted. If you see anyone dumping trash, please call the Sheriff's Dept. Accepted Materials include; appliances, dryers, drained hot water tanks, refrigerators and freezers with doors removed. Also accepted are bulky items such as overstuffed furniture, mattresses, box springs, and other furniture. Metals of various types will also be accepted

EXCEPT new or used metal drums or barrels of any size, ex: 55 gal. drums.

NO items should be over 12 feet in length. Old window glass can be included in your regular sanitation pick-up.

### ITEMS NOT ACCEPTABLE

include any item containing gasoline, garbage, construction and demolition materials, ex: plasterboard, concrete, bricks, wood, roofing materials, poisons, acids, caustics, explosives, ashes, brush, junk vehicles, animal waste, compost materials, tires, batteries and used motor oil.

PLEASE MARK any container which you do not want taken during cleanup "SAVE"; as the Town WILL NOT be responsible for them, nor will they replace any items put at roadside in error. Questions contact:
