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LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY OR DECLARATION

A State of Emergency is hereby declared in the Town of Marilla for a period of time beginning at 1600 hours on the date of March 17, 2020 and continuing in effect for a period of time not to exceed, thirty (30) days and ending at 1600 hours on the date of April 17, 2020.

The State of Emergency has been declared due to emergency conditions produced by:

Public Health crisis caused by the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Such conditions threaten or imperil the public safety of the residents and businesses in the Town of Marilla.

As Chief Executive of the Town of Marilla, I, Earl Gingerich Jr., Town Supervisor have exercised the authority given to me under New York State Executive Law 2-B, to preserve the public safety and render all required and available assistance vital to the security, well-being and health of the citizens of the community.

I hereby direct the Department(s) of: All Town of Marilla Departments to take whatever steps necessary to protect life and property, public infrastructure and other such emergency assistance as deemed necessary.

FURTHER, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 24 of the Article 2-B of the New York State Executive Law to temporary suspend or modify and statute, local law, ordinance, order, rule, or regulation or parts thereof, of any agency during a State disaster emergency, if compliance with such statute, local law, ordinance, order, rule, or regulation would prevent, hinder, or delay action necessary to cope with disaster emergency or if necessary to assist or aid in coping with such disaster, I hereby temporary suspend or modify, for the period from the date of this Executive Order through April 17, 2020 the following:

Suspension of laws to allow waiver of requirements necessary for apportionment of school aid:

This Executive Order will serve as a State of Emergency pursuant to Executive Order 202.1 Issued by Governor Cuomo relative to Section 3407 of the Education Law.

Suspension of laws and regulations relating to emergency procurement:

The Town of Marilla Procurement Policy and Contract of Management Policy is hereby suspended to the extent necessary to purchase necessary equipment, material, supplies, or service without the following the standard procurement processes, including the standard prompt health and safety of our employees and citizens of Marilla.

Under this authority, the Supervisor is hereby closing the following locations: Community Center and Suspending Senior Services. These are closed to the general public and such closures will remain in effect until further notice. This will exclude employees of the Town and contracted agencies. Please contact the Town Hall for any inquires not addressed by this Executive Order.

A strict health and safety protocol will be active and enforced. All Planning Board and Conservation Advisory Board meetings will be postponed for thirty (30) days.

Further and under this authority, Building Permits will continue to be processed and issued, but specific questions should be addressed to the Building Department at 716-652-5350. Ext 414.

Further and under this authority, services provided by the Town of Marilla Town Clerk's Office will be limited. There will be no evening hours for the next thirty (30) days. Please contact the Town Clerk's Office at 716-622-5350, ext. 402 for questions.
